VOLUNTEER INFORMATION SHEET

If you have a group of four or more, please call the Habitat office, so that we may discuss scheduling your group. Children under the age of 16 are not allowed on the construction site unless approved by the Construction Manager.

We meet at our designated meeting location at 7:45 a.m. Construction activities should be complete by 3pm. When you arrive, each member of your group will need to fill out the Volunteer Registration Sheet, sign in and get a name badge.

Wear comfortable work clothes and sturdy shoes (no sandals). A hat, sunscreen and lightweight raincoat or rain poncho may be needed. In the event of inclement weather, work may be delayed or cancelled, but we ask scheduled groups to report to the job site for verification from the Construction Manager.

Under the direction of qualified Construction Leaders, volunteers will participate in house framing, roofing, vinyl siding installation, painting, landscaping and cleanup on the home construction site. Due to a limited number of hand tools, we ask that volunteers bring hammers, nail aprons and work gloves with them to the construction site.

Drinking water will be provided at each worksite throughout the day. We are currently providing lunch through donations from local restaurants. Eating lunch on-site is a great bonding experience between volunteers and homeowners and we encourage groups to do so.

First-Aid supplies will be available, if needed. For serious injury, call 911 and immediately report to Habitat personnel.
